



## STATEMENT OF VIET NAM

At the Review of the 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle UPR Report of Maldives

(Wednesday, May 6, 2015)

Mr. President,

Viet Nam welcomes and thanks the delegation of Maldives for its presentation.
