Romania welcomes the distinguished delegation of Mongolia and the second participation in the UPR exercise.

We took note of the general political commitment of the Mongolian authorities expressed in the national report on the intention to continue to upheld the highest human rights standards.

We have the following recommandations for Mongolia:

- 1) To continue its efforts in order to ensure the right to education for the children
- 2) To apply the commitments undertaken under the national legislation for the protection of the more vulnerable citizens, notably, the children, the senior citizens and the persons with disabilities.
