Statement of the Delegation of the Sudan
Review of the United States of America Monday,11 May 2015

Mr. President,

Despite the progress mentioned in the national report since the last review in 2010, we still remain concerned about the situations of the human rights in the **United States of America**. We urge the government to eliminate any form of racial discrimination in employment, housing, education and health as well as discrimination against persons with disabilities, migrants and indigenous people.

Mr. President,

Sudan would like to present to, **the United States of America** the following recommendations:

1. Consider the establishment of a national human rights institution;
2. To bring its legislations and laws in line with human rights obligations;
3. To ratify the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities and ILO's Convention No 111 on Discrimination in Employment and Occupation.
4. To improve living conditions in prisons in particular in Guantanamo as well as prevent, detect and respond to sexual abuse in federal, state and local confinement facilities also provide greater protection for Juvenile in adult facilities.
5. To implement the strategic action plan on human trafficking as well as to strengthen services for trafficking victims.
