Statement by Rwanda delivered by Moses Rugema

Thank you Mr. President.

- o Rwanda welcomes the delegation of Australia and thanks them for the presentation of their national report.
- We note with concern the continued operations at sea against refugees and asylum seekers and their detention and alleged ill treatment.
- o While we recognise progress in relation to equality and nondiscrimination in Australia, we remain concerned at the continued disparities in access to services for aboriginal and other indigenous communities and continued discrimination and racism.

Rwanda has the following recommendations:

- Ensure that conditions of detention are line with international norms and standards in particular the detention of migrants and asylum seekers.
- Ensure that Australia leaves up to its international obligations regarding asylum seekers and refugees.
- Ensure that Aboriginal and other indigenous communities are accorded equal access to services including to judicial remedies for discrimination and racism.

We wish Australia every success in the implementation of the recommendations accepted at this UPR.
