



*Statement by the Delegation of Cambodia
At the 23rd Session of the Universal Period Review
Working Group on Myanmar's National Report
06 November 2015 at 09.00-12.30*

Mr. President,

- 1. At the outset, my delegation wishes to warmly welcome the delegation of Myanmar, led by H.E. Dr. Tun Shin, Attorney-General, to the 23rd Session of the UPR Working Group.*
- 2. My delegation is pleased with succinct presentation of a comprehensive National Report of Myanmar.*
- 3. Therefore, we sincerely praise Myanmar's commitments in further enhancing the promotion and protection of human rights, and in upholding the fundamental freedom of its people, especially the freedom of faith, which is guaranteed both in law and practice in this country.*
