Mr. President,

Slovenia commends Myanmar for becoming party to the CRPD and OP CRC on the sale of children, child prostitution and child pornography and welcomes the efforts to ensure affordable education and the inclusion of human rights education in the school curriculum.

We are concerned about the legislation that provides different categories of citizenship and about the persistent violations and abuses of human rights against Rohingya Muslims and persons belonging to other minorities.

We would like to reiterate our **recommendation** from the first cycle asking Myanmar to ratify and fully implement all core human rights treaties, including ICCPR and CAT, as well as offer the following additional **recommendations**:

- to adopt legislation ensuring protection of human rights of ethnic communities, including by ensuring their participation in governments decisions;
- to repeal all discriminatory legal provisions such as granting citizenship on the basis of ethnicity or race and providing for different citizenship categories;
- to prevent discriminatory local orders and practice of restricting marriages for Rohingya people and pregnancy for Muslim women aimed at reducing the number of their children;
- to ensure better representation of women and their priorities in the peace process;
- to abolish death penalty.
