**Statement of the Republic of Korea**

Thank you, Mr. President.

The Republic of Korea warmly welcomes the delegation of the Government of Oman. We commend the Government of Oman on the overall progress that has been achieved in the promotion and protection of human rights since its first UPR.

In particular, we note with appreciation the withdrawal or modification of the reservations to the five articles of the Convention on the Rights of the Child, as well as the receipt of the country visit by the Special Rapporteur on the rights to freedom of peaceful assembly and of association.

Bearing this progress in mind, my delegation would like to make the following three recommendations;

**First, we recommend that the Government of Oman consider acceding to the ICCPR and the ICESCR.**

**Second, we recommend that the Government of Oman fully and effectively implement the recommendations by the Special Rapporteur on the rights to freedom of peaceful assembly and of association, following his mission to Oman in September 2014.**

**Third, we recommend that the Government of Oman consider amending its domestic laws to grant Omani women equal rights with men with regard to transmission of their nationality to their children as the Republic of Korea previously recommended in the first UPR.**
