Georgia commends the Government of Saint Kitts and Nevis for efforts aimed at poverty reduction, including introduction of National Social Protection Strategy and Action Plan for 2013-2017.

Georgia welcomes the establishment of National Education Foundation, which is designed to help disadvantaged students through offering scholarships and grant programs.

Having said that, Georgia recognizes that more steps are required in order to reach desirable results, therefore we recommend

- to work closely with the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights in order to seek its assistance in meeting the obligations to UN Treaty Bodies and implementing the recommendations received under the UPR.
