Review of Saint Kitts and Nevis
Statement by Armenia

Armenia welcomes the delegation of Saint Kitts and Nevis and thanks for the presentation of the national report.

We appreciate that Saint Kitts and Nevis has taken measures to further improve education quality and accessibility. We also note the progress made in the promotion of the right to health, as well as the Social Protection Strategy for 2013-2017, which prioritizes a number of vulnerable groups for social protection initiatives, including persons with disabilities.

We, however, note that Saint Kitts and Nevis has not ratified the core international human rights instruments and treaties since its first review.

Our delegation has the following recommendations for Saint Kitts and Nevis:

1. To ratify the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide;
2. to ratify the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights;
3. to ratify the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights

We wish Saint Kitts and Nevis success in its second review.
