Thank you, Mr. Chairman,

Bulgaria warmly welcomes the distinguished delegation of Belgium and thanks for the comprehensive national report.

- 2. To continue giving priority attention to domestic and gender-based violence, in particular rape and other crimes of sexual violence, at all relevant levels, including such caused by police and the judiciary.
- 3. To ensure that all persons deprived of liberty are held in humane conditions, including in line with the UN Basic Principles for the Treatment of Prisoners and the Standard Minimum Rules for the treatment of prisoners.
