STATEMENT BY THE DELEGATION OF GHANA DELIVERED BY MR. JOSEPH OWUSU-ANSAH, FIRST SECRETARY ON THURSDAY 21ST JANUARY, 2016

Ghana warmly welcomes the distinguished delegation of Denmark to this Session. Ghana notes with appreciation steps taken to improve the human rights situation in Denmark since the first cycle review such as the establishment of a special office for children as part of the Danish Parliamentary Ombudsman Institution and the Disability Pension.

Ghana also lauds actions taken by Denmark to implement a significant number of recommendations it accepted during the first review.

Ghana wishes to recommend to Denmark to consider:

- To ratify the International Convention on the Protection of the Rights of All Migrant Workers and Members of Their Families;
- To ratify the International Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced Disappearances; and
- To ratify the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights;

Ghana wishes Denmark a successful review.
