Statement of the Islamic Republic of Iran 24st Session of the UPR Working Group Review of the Republic of Denmark 21 January 2016

In the name of God, the Compassionate, the Merciful

Mr. President,

While thanking the delegation of Denmark for the presentation of its national report, we would like to express our deep concern over a number of human rights issues in the country including:

- -Discrimination in employment, education and housing against minorities and migrants especially Muslims.
- Increasing hate speech against refugee and Muslim people through social media.
- -The large number of children who are living without their parents and are placed in care outside their home.

Therefore, we would like to make the following recommendations to Denmark:

- To ratify the International Convention on the Protection of the Rights of All Migrant Workers and Members of their Families (ICRMW).
- -To adopt legislation to prohibit all forms of discrimination on the basis of race, color, ethnicity, age, religion and disability and to ensure access to effective remedy for victims of discrimination.

- -To take concrete measures to put and end to Islamophobia and hate speech regarding Muslims, which continues to be widespread in public and political debate.
- -To adopt practical and legal measures to strengthen the foundation of the family and avoid resorting to measures and legislation which endanger the very foundation of the family in society.
- To take necessary measures in orders to prevent and combat sexual exploitation and abuse of vulnerable people especially in Greenland.
