STATEMENT BY SINGAPORE AT THE UNIVERSAL PERIODIC REVIEW (UPR) OF THE KINGDOM OF DENMARK AT THE 24th UPR WORKING GROUP, 21 JANUARY 2016

Mr President,

Singapore warmly welcomes the delegation of Denmark to the 24th UPR Working Group.
