

STATEMENT BY THE DELEGATION OF INDONESIA
24th SESSION OF THE WORKING GROUP ON UNIVERSAL PERIODIC REVIEW
CONSIDERATION OF THE NATIONAL REPORT OF NAMIBIA
GENEVA, 18 JANUARY 2016

Mr. President,

My delegation would like to thank the delegation of Namibia, for the presentation of their national report and continued engagement in the UPR process.

Indonesia commends the Government of Namibia for their efforts in improving the promotion and protection of human rights, especially by launching and implementing the National Human Rights Action Plan 2015-2019.

Mr. President,

Indonesia notes the improvements on the minimum wage and supplementary minimum conditions of employment for domestic workers as reflected under the Labour Act 11 of 2007. In addition, my delegation is of the view that measures can be taken to manage and prevent the exploitation of migrant workers. Therefore, **Indonesia recommends the Government of Namibia to consider the ratification of the International Convention on the Protection of the Rights of All Migrant Workers and Members of Their Families.**

Indonesia also acknowledges the steps taken by the Government of Namibia to combat trafficking in persons, and therefore **recommends the Government of Namibia to continue its efforts in drafting the Human Trafficking Legislation, with the active participation of civil society.**

To conclude, Indonesia would like to offer its best wishes to the Government and people of Namibia in their future endeavors towards the promotion and protection of human rights at all levels.
