



STATEMENT BY MALAYSIA Review of Paraguay 24th Session of the Universal Periodic Review Working Group of the Human Rights Council, 18 – 29 January 2016

Mr President,

Malaysia welcomes the delegation of Paraguay to the 24th Session of the UPR Working Group and thanks them for the presentation of their report.

- 2. Malaysia commends Paraguay for its overall progress in the promotion and protection of human rights towards building a democratic society in the country. We acknowledge the steps taken by the Government for the improvement of economic and social rights including reducing illiteracy and poverty.
- 3. We encourage Paraguay to implement its Commitments and Voluntary Undertakings as outlined in its national report and would also like to offer the following **four recommendations**:
 - 3.1 **One**: Effectively combat human trafficking, in particular sexual exploitation and forced labour;
 - 3.2 **Two**: Provide assistance, reintegration programmes and skills training for victims of human trafficking to allow their reintegration into society;
 - 3.3 Three: Continue efforts towards improving literacy and reducing poverty through education and skills enhancement programmes under the National Development Plan 2030; and
 - 3.4 Four: Double efforts in combatting corruption through improving the capacity of the National Secretariat to Combat Corruption
