Interactive Dialogue on Report of **Singapore**

Mr. President,

The Republic of Serbia acknowledges many important achievements in promotion of human rights in Singapore since its first UPR review. We welcome continuous efforts for upholding socio-economic rights and enhancing social cohesion, such as the initiative to expand access to healthcare as demonstrated by launching the Medishield Life in 2015, as well as taking care of the elderly.

We offer the following two recommendations to Singapore:

1. Take adequate measures to prevent trafficking in women and children and to strengthen the protection of victims of human trafficking;
2. Continue incorporating the CEDAW provisions into its domestic legal system in order to eliminate all forms of discrimination against women.

With regard to the civil and political rights, we would encourage Singapore to explore the possibility of accepting the universally prescribed standards in this field and to consider ratifying the ICCPR.

We wish Singapore success in implementing the recommendations of its second cycle.
