on the Universal Periodic Review (UPR)

GREECE at the 25th session of the UPR

GENEVA, 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2016.

Kenya warmly welcomes the delegation of Greece to the UPR discussions and thank the Secretary General for Transparency and Human Rights for his detailed report which provides the efforts of Greece in implementing the last UPR recommendations to promote and protect human rights.
