Timor-Leste warmly welcomes the members of the Delegation of Ireland and congratulates them for their participation at the 25th session of the UPR Working Group.

Timor-Leste welcomes the adoption of the Children (Amendment) Act 2015 which repeals all provisions permitting the detention of children in adult prison facilities, as well as the strengthening of the Inpatient Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service.

Timor-Leste wishes to make the following recommendations:

- That Ireland continues implementing human rights education towards children and women's rights
- That Ireland ratifies the International Convention on the Protection of the Rights of All Migrant Workers and Members of their Families
