STATEMENT BY THE CZECH REPUBLIC

The Czech Republic warmly welcomes the delegation of Ireland. (We appreciate the informative presentation today including the response to some of our advance questions).

We make the following **recommendations**:

- to complete as a matter of priority and before its third UPR the process leading to the ratification of the Optional Protocol to the Convention against Torture and establish a national preventive mechanism without delay;
- to establish a system providing children and their parents the real opportunity to choose from among religious, multi-denominational or non-denominational types of schooling and curricula;
- to broaden through an inclusive public debate the access to abortion for pregnant women, in particular in cases of threat to health, rape and incest;
- to ratify the Optional Protocol to the Convention on the Rights of the Child on the sale of children, child prostitution and child pornography signed in 2000.
