Statement by Pakistan for Samoa UPR (25th Session of Working Group on UPR) 3 May 2016

Mr. President

My delegation would like to thank ----- for the comprehensive presentation of Samoa's national report on UPR.

My delegation takes note with appreciation of the progress made by Samoa in follow up to the first cycle of UPR despite challenges such as lack of resources. We appreciate the efforts of the Samoa government for gender equality, the enhancement of the rights of women and children, economic empowerment, better law and order situation and access to justice.

The legislative reforms to achieve compliance with the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women (CEDAW) and Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC) are encouraging.

We also noted measures to establish and improve national institutions like the Ombudsman Office, National Human Rights Institution and Samoa Law Reform Commission for practical implementation, and follow-up of legislative reforms.

- 1. Samoa to consider ratifying Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CRPD);

- 3. As pointed out in their national report we also urge the international community to recognize the challenges Samoa is facing and provide Samoa with technical assistance to meet its obligations.

We, once again, thank the delegation of Samoa for a comprehensive presentation of the National Report on UPR and wish them the best during the review.
