Mr. President

Uganda welcomes the delegation of the Sudan to their 2nd cycle of the PUR.

We note the efforts made by the Government and the achievements since the last review which include:

1. Adoption of the Anti-human Trafficking Act 2014
2. The freedom of information act 2015
3. The Asylum act 2014
4. The Health insurance act 2016
5. The National Action Plan on Human Rights (2013-2023)

We also note the challenges facing Sudan such as the universal coercive measures, foreign debt and the armed conflict.

Uganda recommends that the Sudan devotes more effort to addressing the outstanding human rights issues through the National Action Plan. In this regard the government should provide both financial and human resources for its implementation. We urge the International community to offer the necessary technical support for this.
