Statement by Myanmar Delegation  
25<sup>th</sup> session of the UPR Working Group of  
the Republic of the Sudan

Mr. President,

My delegation warmly welcomes the delegation of the Republic of the Sudan. We thank them for the national report and updated information.

We noted, with satisfaction, that the government of the Republic of the Sudan has adopted a series of laws, including the Anti-Human Trafficking Act of 2014. We commend the formation of the National Committee for Combating Human Trafficking, in accordance with the Anti-Trafficking Act.

We also take note of the adoption of the ten-year National Plan to Promote and Protect Human Rights in the Sudan (2013-2023).

My delegation would like to make the following recommendations;

- Continue efforts to combat human trafficking, particularly of vulnerable groups, such as women and children.
- Continue to seek assistance from the international community in line with its national plan.
