Statement of the Republic of Korea

Thank you, Mr. President.

The Republic of Korea thanks the United Republic of Tanzania for its national report and efforts made over the last five years to improve the country's human rights situations.

My delegation would like to **recommend** Tanzania the following:

1. To extend a standing invitation to all Special Procedures; and
2. To continue to exert concrete efforts to eliminate all forms of discrimination and violence against women and children.

We congratulate Tanzania for the peaceful General Elections held in October last year, and acknowledge the country's accomplishment since their first UPR including adoption of the National Human Rights Action Plan and efforts to reduce the maternal mortality rate.

My government has provided Tanzania with Official Development Assistance in the areas of education and health among others, and Korea stands ready to contribute to further improvement of basic infrastructure to protect and improve human rights conditions of Tanzania.
