Intervention by Ukraine

Mr. President,

Ukraine welcomes the delegation of the United Republic of Tanzania and thanks for the presentation of the National Report.

We would like to acknowledge the Tanzanian Government's efforts to comply with international human rights standards, as well as its achievements and accomplishments in line with the recommendations from the first UPR cycle.

Ukraine believes that particular emphasis should be placed on ensuring right to food by addressing food insecurity and malnutrition in some regions of the country due to the effects of drought. This challenge could be tackled by allocating adequate resources through governmental or international donor funding.

Ukraine would like **to recommend:**

- to continue improving security of citizens and enhancing protection of particularly vulnerable groups such as women and children as well as promoting equality and countering discrimination with a focus on racial or religious discrimination and persons with albinism;
- to consider issuing a standing invitation to the special procedures;
- to consider the possibility of ratifying CAT and ICPPED.
