REPUBLIC OF ANGOLA STATEMENT ON THE ADOPTION OF THE UNITED REPUBLIC  
OF TANZANIA ON THE SECOND CYCLE OF THE UPR

Mr. President,

The Republic of Angola would like to welcome and congratulate the delegation of Tanzania for the ~~submission~~ <sup>PRESNTATION</sup> of its report for the second UPR cycle.

We congratulate Tanzania for their efforts in fulfilling their obligations to the United Nations mechanisms within the protection and promotion of human rights.

Angola notes with satisfaction progress made by Tanzania in improving access to the education system, for implementing the 2014-2020 Plan of Action for the prevention and control of Malaria, and the substantial increase in participation of women in decision-making positions.

However, we are note with concern the major challenges that Tanzania still has to face <sup>namely</sup> in the health sector, ~~as well as certain cases of acts of discrimination against children~~ <sup>concerning</sup> children with albinism, disabled, and infected with HIV-AIDS. We also appeal the Government of Tanzania to pay more attention to young pregnant girls.

Angola would recommend the Republic of Tanzania to:

- Establish a moratorium on the death penalty with a view to its abolition;
- Implement effective measures to prevent and reduce infant and neonatal mortality in the context of the 2016-2020 Roadmap;

Angola wishes the delegation of Tanzania success in the second UPR.
