## STATEMENT BY THE DELEGATION OF INDONESIA 25<sup>th</sup> SESSION OF THE WORKING GROUP ON UNIVERSAL PERIODIC REVIEW CONSIDERATION OF THE UPR REPORT OF THAILAND GENEVA, 11 MAY 2016

Mr. President.

My delegation thanks the Delegation of Thailand for presenting their national report and constructive engagement with the UPR Process.

Indonesia appreciates the various efforts taken by the Government of Thailand on the promotion and protection of human rights in the aims since the first UPR cycle. - To continue efforts to combat IUU fishing, including illegal labor in the fisheries sector, taking into account its human rights and extraterritorial dimensions.

For its part, Indonesia stands ready to continue its constructive cooperation and engagement through bilateral, ASEAN, and international channels with Thailand.

Indonesia wishes Thailand all the best in its future endeavors towards the promotion and protection of human rights at all levels.
