Statement of the Delegation of the Sudan
Review of Thailand

Mr .President,

The delegation of the Sudan welcomes the distinguished delegation of Thailand headed by the Honourable ^{permanent Secretary at the Ministry of Justice} and thanks him for the comprehensive presentation of the national report.

We commend the positive engagement of Thailand to the UPR process and appreciate the legal developments since the previous review in particular the amendment to the 2008 Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act aims to further intensify the country's efforts to combat trafficking in persons and the Justice Fund Act of 2015 to ensure that everyone have an equal access to Justice.

1. To continue its efforts to implement the Policies and Strategies for the prevention and Responses to Violence against Children and Youth of 2015 2021.
