At the Review of the 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle UPR Report of Thailand By Mdm. Le Duc Hanh, Deputy Permanent Representative

Mr. President,

Viet Nam warmly welcomes the delegation of Thailand led by H.E. Mr. Charnchao Chaiyanukij, Permanent Secretary of Ministry of Justice to the 2<sup>nd</sup> UPR cycle and highly appreciate Thailand's recent achievements illustrated in the report.
