Statement by Mr. Shalva Tsiskarashvili, Permanent Representative
The 25th Session of the UPR Working Group
UPR of Trinidad and Tobago

Geneva, 10 May 2016

We warmly welcome the Delegation of Trinidad and Tobago and thank the Head of Delegation for the presentation.

Georgia commends Trinidad and Tobago for the ratification the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CERD), the adoption of a comprehensive Trafficking in Persons Act and the Children Act.

We also welcome the submission of a mid-term implementation report regarding the recommendations accepted during the previous UPR and encourage the Government to continue this practice.

Georgia **recommends** the Government of Trinidad and Tobago:

- To develop policy and legislation in the area of protection of the rights of person with disabilities;
- To extend a standing invitation to all Special Procedures mandate holders.
